Bio Aron Raams

Aron Raams was born in 1979 in Oosterhout; a small town in the south of the Netherlands. He was raised in a musically gifted family and picked up the guitar at the age of 6. Inspired by blues and rock guitarists like Robben Ford, Peter Green, Leo Kottke Stevie Ray Vaughan, Jeff Beck & Eric Clapton; he played in several rock and blues bands all through his teens. He enrolled Conservatory in Tilburg, The Netherlands from which he graduated in 2003. It was there that he got inspired by Bill Frisell, Pat Metheny and John Scofield. While still in school he started to build up his reputation in the Dutch music scene as a versatile guitar player with a fine taste for blues and rock.

In 2008 his first album, Unspoken, was released and was nominated for the public Edison Music Award.

Before becoming the musical director of internationally acclaimed lounge band Gare du Nord and main endorcer for Mayson Guitars, Aron worked with many Dutch artists en leading musicians from around the globe.
